Commissioners' Board Meeting July 3, 2008

The Berks County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Thursday, July 3, 2008, at 10:30 A.M. in the Board meeting room on the thirteenth floor of the Berks County Services Center, pursuant to due notice to Board members and the public.

Commissioner Chair Mark C. Scott called the meeting to order with Commissioner Christian Leinbach and Commissioner Kevin Barnhardt in attendance. Also present were the Chief Clerk Terry L. Styer, County Solicitor Alan Miller, Esq. and County Administrator William E. Dennis.

Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Leinbach made a motion that was seconded by Commissioner Barnhardt to approve the June 24, 2008 Commissioner workshop minutes and the June 26, 2008 Commissioners meeting minutes, all voted yes to approve.
