Building Connections

This past year our outreach team focused on bringing our employer and community partners together to share their successes and challenges specific to the transportation industry. Over **twenty** meetings were conducted providing a space for peer interaction. We held conversations surrounding telecommuting, TDM within college campuses, recruitment, retention, wellness, transit routes, and bike share initiatives. Participants have expressed their interest in future meetings and have enjoyed the opportunity to learn and expand their knowledge to grow their own organizations.

Highlights

Evaluating our rideshare and rewards data each year gives us a glimpse into what is working and what needs improvement. Check out key findings below.

- Outreach meetings/events prove to increase participation within the database. - 84% of new trackers in 2023 were from participating employers.
- Active Transportation trips tracked increased 14% from 2022.
- Commute PA rideshare users are accessing the program through their app more than ever before.
 - Since 2018 we have seen an increase of 44% in app users.
 - Our team along with Reading Hospital Tower Health and Penske Racing Shocks had another successful Bike to Work Ride in Reading. Event was highlighted by the donation of brand new Trek Police e-bikes to two local municipalities
 - Ashley Furniture continued to stand out among employers in the county providing employees access to Commute PA services at all times with a display in the HR office. Currently they have **492** employees enrolled and recorded **1,451** trips in 2023.
 - Staff attended over **7** job fairs in Berks County linking job seekers to transportation resources giving them more access to jobs.
