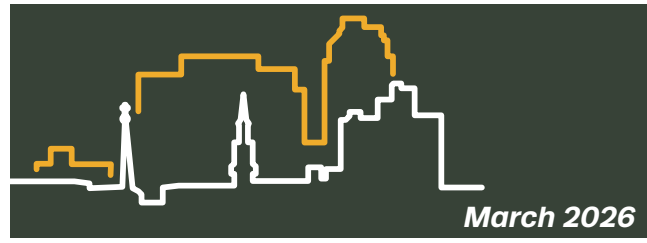

Traffic Count Season

As the weather warms up, it also marks the start of traffic counting season for the Berks County Planning Commission. From early March through mid-November, staff travel throughout the county collecting traffic data at dozens of locations identified by PennDOT. You may notice small rubber tubes stretched across roadways or staff members observing traffic at intersections as part of this work. These counts help measure how many vehicles travel our roads and what types of vehicles are using them, providing important data used to plan roadway improvements, improve safety, and better understand transportation needs across Berks County. If you happen to see our team out in the field, please drive carefully around the equipment and feel free to give them a friendly wave as they help keep our communities moving safely.
